AUTOIMMUNE DISEASES

The National Institute of Health reported that there are over 80 autoimmune diseases. These diseases impact 24 million Americans (NIH, 2005). Some common autoimmune diseases include type 1 diabetes, multiple sclerosis, lupus, and rheumatoid arthritis. Other diseases are rare and difficult to diagnose such as anti-NMDAR and Still's disease. Still's disease, a type of arthritis, presents with symptoms such as fever, rash, swollen painful joints, muscle pain, and sore throat.



The ALL Foundation was created in honor of Anthony Rodriguez who passed away as a result of Still's disease.

His symptoms started out as the common flu with high fevers then escalated to joint pains and not having the ability to fully speak and walk on his own. He later began experiencing a rash, high ferritin levels and an enlarged spleen. Unfortunately, in three weeks Anthony's battle with this unknown autoimmune illness ended.
